## Prop 65 STATEMENT

This statement is to inform CCL-Olympic customers about the presences of substances listed on California's Safe Drinking Water & Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, which is commonly known as Proposition 65 (Prop 65), in CCL-Olympic 3000, 5000, 7000, 8000 and 9000 series.

By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.

For the production of adhesives that are used in CCL-Olympic products, a chemical is used that is listed under Prop-65: 2-Ethylhexyl acrylate. This chemical is a common monomer which is frequently used for the production of acrylic adhesive polymers and it might be that residual trace amounts are still present in our products.
